Supply List for Dinosaurs

Paper plates

Colored clothes pins

Paint

Brush

Foam

Liquid Glue

Construction paper

Black marker

Pattern – found at the end of the document

Instructions

1. Paint the underside of a paper plate. Let dry
2. Using the pattern, cut out the head and tail of the Dinosaur. Using construction paper, cut out the scales of the back ridge. Put aside.
3. Fold the plate in half. Attach the scales with glue to the inside of the plate. Look at the example for guidance.
4. Attach the head and the tail. You will need to apply pressure for a few minutes.
5. Staple the plate together, making sure that you staple the head and the tail to give it extra support.
6. Attach the clothes pins to make feet.
