Supply list for Rainbow Fish

Paper Plates

Glitter glue

Googly eyes

Sequins

Liquid glue

Blue paint

Brush

Foam

Red marker

Pattern – found at the end of this document

Instructions

1. Paint the underside of the paper plate. Let dry.
2. While the plate is drying, cut out the pattern for the fins using the foam. Put aside.
3. Dot glue around the plate. Put sequins on the dots of glue.
4. Place eye on plate using a dot of glue. Using a black marker draw on eye lashes.
5. Use the glitter glue to draw scales.
6. Draw a mouth with the red marker.
7. Glue on cut out foam as it is in the sample. You made need to apply a few moments of pressure.
8. The glitter glue needs a lot of time to dry.
9. Enjoy your masterpiece!
